MEMORANDUM FOR ALL DIRECTORATES, SPECIAL STAFF AND SUBORDINATE USJFCOM COMMANDS

Subject: Promulgation of USJFCOM Restructuring Decisions

1. In accordance with reference (a), I am disestablishing specified subordinate U.S. Joint Forces Command (USJFCOM) commands and setting the conditions to disestablish other specified subordinate USJFCOM commands, as identified herein.

a. Effective immediately, the Joint Warfighting Center (JWFC) is disestablished as a subordinate command. All responsibilities and functions performed at JWFC will be performed under the direction and authority of the J-7 Director. The J-7 Directorate is re-designated Joint Training Directorate in order to capitalize on its reputation as a premier training venue. This re-designation does not require that the Joint Warfighting Center be renamed.


b. Effective immediately, the Joint Futures Lab (JFL) is disestablished as a subordinate command. All responsibilities and functions performed at JFL will be performed under the direction and authority of the J-9 Director. The J-9 Directorate is re-designated Joint Concept Development and Experimentation Directorate.

c. The following organizations will no longer be "Commands" within USJFCOM. The current Commanders/Commanding Officers of these organizations shall submit a new Charter for approval no later than 1 April 2010. Transition from Subordinate Command will occur upon approval of new Charters.

- Joint Personnel Recovery Agency (JPRA) currently established and operating under USJFCOMINST 3100.4, 22 Nov 2000 (Subject to the caveat at paragraph 3).
- Joint Fires Integration and Interoperability Team (JFIIT) currently established and operating under USJFCOM Directive 5170.2, 30 Nov 2007.
- Joint Unmanned Aircraft System Center of Excellence (JUAS-COE) currently established and operating under USJFCOM Directive 5170.3, 14 Nov 2007.
- Joint Public Affairs Support Element (JPASE) (No current Charter on file).
- Joint Transformation Command - Intelligence (JTC-I) (No current Charter on file).
- Joint System Integration Command (JSIC) (No current Charter on file).

2. These organizations, except for Joint System Integration Command (JSIC) and Joint Transformation Command - Intelligence (JTC-I) may use their existing name and may describe themselves as an Agency, Activity, Center, Team or Support Element, as appropriate. Joint System Integration Command will be renamed as the Joint System Integration Center. Joint Transformation Command - Intelligence will be renamed as the Joint Intelligence Operations Center (JIOC).

3. JPRA will not implement this decision until the review of the DoD Executive Agent for Personnel Recovery is complete and the continuance of USJFCOM's role as the Executive Agent is confirmed.
4. When practicable, to avoid duplication and to achieve maximum efficiency and economy these Directorates will use and leverage existing systems, facilities and services from within USJFCOM Headquarters.
5. All Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) authority held by the Commanders and Commanding Officers listed in paragraphs 1.a., 1.b. and 1.c. is withdrawn upon approval of their re-designation as Directors. The administration of UCMJ authority within USJFCOM will be conducted in accordance with reference (b).
6. The Senior Officer Present for Administration (SOPA) of the Suffolk complex will exercise all functions pertaining to the security, order, management and administration of the Suffolk Complex, excepting only that questions of Federal trespass and debarment must now be referred to the Commander, USJFCOM for approval, via the Command Group. The SOPA, a General/Flag Officer assigned to the Suffolk complex, will be designated in writing by the USJFCOM Chief of Staff. This delegation of responsibility for administration of the complex applies even when Commander, USJFCOM or other General/Flag Officer senior to the SOPA is physically present on the Suffolk complex.
