### MEMORANDUM FOR THE UNDER SECRETARY OF DEFENSE FOR INTELLIGENCE

Subject: Redesignation of U.S. Joint Forces Command (USJFCOM) Joint Intelligence Transformation – Intelligence (JTC-I) as Joint Intelligence Operations Center (JIOC)

1. Per the Chairman's guidance in reference (a), I have directed that Joint Transformation Command – Intelligence (JTC-I), established in reference (b), be redesignated as the USJFCOM Joint Intelligence Operations Center (JIOC) subordinate activity under the USJFCOM Director of Intelligence (J2).
2. I will retain ultimate authority over the JIOC capability to provide direct intelligence support to USJFCOM missions. USJFCOM JIOC will continue to serve as the premier intelligence organization for the command, consolidating the J2 staff and former JTC-I elements into a single, unified organization led by the USJFCOM Senior Intelligence Officer (SIO) in supporting USJFCOM missions and Commander's priorities. The J2 is designated the Coordinating Authority, as defined in reference (c), over all matters pertaining to the JIOC's contribution to the USJFCOM mission. The designated JIOC Director will be responsible for the execution of daily JIOC intelligence operations in accordance with USJFCOM policy, mission priorities, and Commander/J2 guidance.
3. The mission of the JIOC is to develop, integrate, train, and provide joint intelligence capabilities to meet present and future needs of the joint force. Inherent to the JIOC's mission is its permanent role as a supporting organization to USJFCOM and USJFCOM subordinate forces, as well as other commands, forces and agencies, as appropriate. In addition, USJFCOM JIOC will continue to support reference (d) tasking to assist the Defense Intelligence Community, the Defense Intelligence Operations Coordination Center (DIOCC), and combatant command JIOCs in achieving the desired end state of integrating intelligence, operations and plans to increase the speed, power, and combat effectiveness of DoD operations.
